Carriere Distalizers — Moving Molars!

Dr. Carriere, from Barcelona, Spain, has developed a new orthodontic appliance to move upper molars back. This also helps us treat overbites, and gain space for the teeth. The appliance cements onto the outside surface of the upper side teeth. The patient then wears rubber bands from the CARRIERE DISTALIZER to the lower molars. Dr. Chapman recently visited Dr. Carriere's office and continues to be very pleased with this appliance.



Anchor Pins — Tooth Anchors!

Developed in Europe and Asia, ANCHOR PINS are little removable implants. By anchoring to the bone, we are now able to move teeth in directions which would otherwise have been extremely difficult or impossible. They greatly reduce the complexity of treatment, especially for adults, where we want to move teeth in preparation for replacement of missing teeth and esthetic restorations. ANCHOR PINS are usually placed by an oral surgeon, or a periodontist (gum specialist), and then we can attach to them right away.

Flex Plan Planning

Don't forget that many employers have fall deadlines for the 2007 flex plan year. We can work with you to help you plan to maximize any flex spending allocations available to you.

Wires — the moving force!

Wires move your teeth, braces are just the handles! Thermal active wires are the wonder wires of orthodontics. At room temperature, or when chilled, these wires are so super flexible, that we can tie them in knots! But at mouth temperature, they spring back to their original shape. This is a great quality to help us align poorly positioned teeth easily and gently. The new thermal active wires have special ionic coatings which reduce their friction, and so enhance the speed of movement with our CARRIERE and DAMON brackets.
